


T. Sahitya, has completed Class 10 from Sri Vijnana Vihara English Medium School with an impressive 93%, scoring 558 out of 600 marks.







Despite losing her father and facing financial challenges, with her mother being a housewife, Nancy has excelled academically. She lives with her grandmother and has one elder sister.


